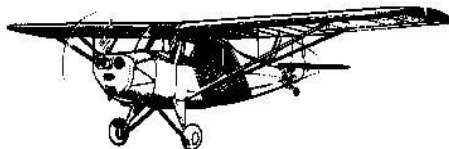
## Directions to the Club's Meetings
