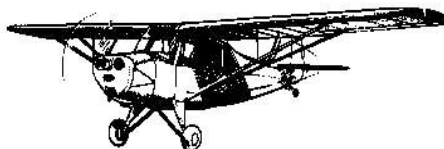
## Directions to the Club's Meetings

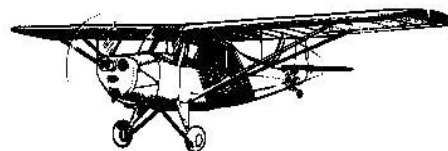

## Refrigerator Eclair Cake Recipe courtesy Mrs. Wersosky

2 small boxes instant vanilla pudding (sometimes I use chocolate)  
3-1/2 cups milk  
1 8-oz container Cool Whip  
24 graham crackers  
3 Tbls. softened margarine  
2 pkgs. liquid chocolate (Choc-O-Bake)  
1-1/2 cups confectioner's sugar  
2 Tbls. vanilla  
3-1/2 tsp. milk

In large bowl, beat pudding with 3-1/2 cups milk. Fold in Cool Whip. Layer 13x9 glass pan with half of graham crackers. Cover with half of pudding mix. Repeat layers. Refrigerate. Beat remaining ingredients until smooth. Spread over top of cake (use a bit more milk if needed to make a soft spreading consistency). Refrigerate at least 4-5 hours.
